First let me share some of my favorite scripture on prayer.

Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the Lord. And she made this vow: "O Lord Almighty, if you will look down upon my sorrow and answer my prayer and give me a son, then I will give him back to you. He will be yours for his entire lifetime, and as a sign that he has been dedicated to the Lord, his hair will never be cut."

I Samuel Chp. 1-9-10

My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

Psalms 5:3

But when you pray, go away by yourself, shut the door behind you, and pray to your Father secretly. Then your Father, who knows all secrets, will reward you.

"When you pray, don't babble on and on as people of other religions do. They think their prayers are answered only by repeating their words again and again. Don't be like them, because your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask him! Pray like this:

Our Father in heaven,

May your name be honored.

May your Kingdom come soon.

May your will be done here on earth,

Just as it is in heaven.

Give us our food for today,

and forgive us our sins,

just as we have forgiven those who have sinned against us.

And don't let us yield to temptation,

but deliver us from the evil one.

"If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Matthew 6:6-15

Now that I have shared some of my most precious scriptures on prayer, let me take a moment and emphasize the text above. I believe that Jesus gave us an awesome glimpse into the spirit when He gave us the Lord's Prayer. In my own prayer life, I use this prayer as a model for how to pray. Taking into consideration Psalms 5, I rise early typically around 5 am to get face time with my God.

When I pray, I pray after the manner of the Lord's Prayer. Mind you, I do not use the specific terminology that Jesus used. I believe that each section has specific meaning and can be used to direct the order of your prayer as well as the substance of your prayer. The following is a guide to help you add structure and substance to your prayer life! I hope that you are blessed by it. Remember Women of Style believe in the Power of Prayer!

Our Father who art in heaven Hallowed be thy Name... This is the opening of your prayer. You always start by acknowledging God for who He is and for the fact that He is Holy and worthy of all praise and glory! This is your opportunity to worship Him. Take as much time as you need...

Thy Kingdom come thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven... In this section you release the will of God to mirror in your life and in the lives of those around you, what God has ordained in heaven. Remember whatsoever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven! Woman thou art loosed!

Give us this day our daily bread... In this section, you are petitioning God for provision in every area of your life and the lives of those around us. Keep in mind, that the Lord's Prayer is not selfish. Women of Style do not prayer selfish prayers! Don't beat around the bush! Be specific about your needs and desires. Be transparent with God.

Forgive us of our sins as we forgive those that sin against us... In this section, you must pray that God will keep your heart pure and cleanse you from anything that would separate you from your power, your purpose, or your promise! Sin is pervasive, and if left unchecked, will spread like a cancer. Keep in mind, you are not just praying for your own forgiveness. This is where intercessors intercede on behalf of people that God may place in your spirit or perhaps Kingdom leadership, family members, etc. Your prayer will be the catalyst to break up the spirit of bitterness, unforgiveness, and hatred.

Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one... In this section you're asking God to keep you from evil desires and fleshly inclinations. You can get as specific as you want. Please know that trials are a part of the the Kingdom believer's growth process, but temptation is not of God (James 1:13). You are praying that God will strengthen your spirit woman to overcome temptation when it is presented to you. Notice Jesus said "lead us not into temptation", He didn't say "lead us not to temptation". Temptation will come your way because the adversary has a mandate to kill, steal, and destroy; but the power of prayer helps you to overcome the adversary!

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever, Amen... In this section, you're closing your prayer by stating that your total trust and confidence is in God! You are confessing that He alone is worthy of all praise, glory, and honor. You are denouncing any spiritual or fleshly allegiance, and affirming your allegiance to God! This ensures that the devil knows that you who's in control.

Finally, I want you to notice, that there is NO WHERE IN THE LORD'S PRAYER TO GRIPE OR COMPLAIN. Do not come into the presence of God with an attitude, griping, complaining, and murmuring. It takes faith to move God! When you come into the presence of God, even if you're hurting, reverence Him and respect Him enough to demonstrate discipline and faith.

Well my beloved Sister, I pray that you will let this information minister to you. It has been a blessing to me, and I decree that it will do the same for you.
